NOTICE OF RACE

1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, including prescriptions of the Scandinavian Sailing Association and the Danish Sailing Association.
- 1.2 The Rules for Danish Championships will apply for Feva XL, Europe, Laser Radial and 29'er.
- 1.3 The Rules are changed as follows:
 - Rules 30.2 and 30.3 will be changed by a prescription of the Scandinavian Sailing Association. The
 base of the triangle in these rules includes the extensions of the starting line to the starting vessel
 and to a control vessel in the opposite end.
 - The preamble to Part 4 will be changed, to state that the obligation to wear personal buoyancy when flag Y is displayed not only applies while racing.
 - Rule 33 will be changed to state, that the official boats will only display race signal C accompanied by sound signals if the course is changed.
 - Rules 35, A4 and A5 will be changed to state, that boats failing to finish within 20 minutes, for Optimist B and C 15 minutes, after the first boat will be scored Did Not Finish.
 - Rule 44.1 will be are changed for Feva XL, 29'er, Hobie Cat 16 Spi and A-cat so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.
 - Rules 60.1(a) will be changed to state, that a competitor cannot protest another boat or competitor for breaches for some specific parts of the sailing instructions.
 - Rule 61.1(b) will be changed to state that protests from the Race officers will be posted on the
 official notice board.
 - Rule 62.1(a) will be changed to state that any deviations from the targeted time cannot be ground for request for redress
 - Rule 62.2 will be changed to shorten the time limit for redress based on a decision of the protest committee.
 - Rule 66 will be changed to shorten the time limit for reopening protest hearings.
 - Rules A4 and A5 will be changed by stating, that a boat starting later than 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start.
 - The race signal AP will be changed when used on land.
 - For B+C Optimist rule 78 is changed to state that Optimist dinghies or dinghies that looks as
 Optimist dinghies can participate without class certificate, as stated in the permit from the Danish
 Sailing Association "Tilladelse til kapsejlads uden krav om gyldigt klassebevis i Optimist klassen".

The changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions. The Sailing Instructions can change other rules than the above mentioned.

2 Advertising

Boats shall display event advertising supplied by the organizing authority.

3 Eligibility and entry

- Eligible boats may enter by using the link on the website www.harboecup.dk to enter the booking system. Handling fee may be charged together with the entry fee. This handling fee does is charged by the platform and is not part of the organizing authority. The entry must be done by Friday September 16, 2016 the latest. This applies for entry fee, service fees and other entries related to the regatta. Entries later than Friday September 16, 2016 will be accepted by paying a 50% higher entry fee.
- 3.4 The following limitations will apply:
 - A minimum of 5 participants in each class is required. If less than 5 participants have entered before the
 time limit, the organizing committee will cancel the regatta for this class. Cancellation of any classes will be
 published on the website www.harboecup.dk on Monday September 19, 2016.
 - A maximum of 80 competitors in each of the classes Optimist B and Optimist C will apply. If the maximum
 is reached, this will be published on the website www.harboecup.dk.

- 5.3 The Race Committee can decide to race in fleets.
- 5.4 Warming signal for the first race on Saturday is at 11.00.

Warning signal for the first race on Sunday is at 10.00.

- 5.5 The attention signal for the following races on the same day will be made as soon as possible.
 - The Race Committee can decide that Feva XL, 29'er, Hobie Cat 16 Spi and A-Cat will sail ashore for lunch.
- New starting procedures cannot be started more than 6 hours after the scheduled starting time of the first race on each day. If the first race is postponed on shore, the limit can be prolonged accordingly. On the last day of the regatta no warning signal will be made after 15.00.

6 Measurement and control

6.1 The Race Committee may perform control of measurement and other requirements according to class rules.

7 Sailing instructions

7.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration, and will be available on the regatta websie www.harboecup.dk just before the regatta.

8 Venue

- 8.1 The regatta harbour will be Skælskør Amatør-Sejlklub at Skælskør Nor, Skælskør Fjord and Kobæk Beach. See www.harboecup.dk for a map displaying the racing areas.
- 8.2 Courses for Feva XL and Tera Pro/Sport will be at Skælskør Nor

Courses for Optimist B+C will be at Skælskør Fjord

Courses for all other classes will be at Kobæk Beach

9 The courses

The courses sailed will for each class be as follows:

10 Penalty system

- For the classes Feva XL, 29'er, Hobie Cat 16 Spi and A-Cat, rule 44.1 has been changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.
- 10.2 Appendix P Special procedures for rule 42 will be in force for Optimist A, Zoom8, Europe and Laser Radial.

When reading Appendix P, each regatta is a separate regatta. This means that penalties related to this appendix will not be carried on to subsequent regattas.

11 Scoring

- 11.1 The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply.
 - For Europe the Low Point System will be modified, granting 1. place 0.75 point.
- 11.2 4 races are required to constitute a series.
- 11.3 a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores..
 - b) When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.







12 Safety

Danish legislation requires every boat to be equipped with personal buoyancy for the number of persons on board at any time.

13 Support boats

- Support boats must be registered in the Bureau or in the booking system stated on www.harboecup.dk.

 Please note that Danish legislation requires license to sail boats powered by motors, if they exceed a certain size.
- 13.2 The Sailing Instructions may include further restrictions or requirements for support boats.

14 Radiocommunication

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

15 Prizes

Prizes will be awarded for each 3 starting boats in the following classes: Optimist, Zoom8, Tera Sport/Pro, Feva XL, up to a maximum of 15 prizes in each class. For all other classes prizes for each 5 starting boats will be awarded, up to a maximum of 15 prizes in each class.

Feva XL, Europe, Laser Radial and 29er the first 3 Danish participants will be awarded with medals from the Danish Sailing Association.

Danish champion can only be a sailor that meets the requirements of the Danish Championship Rules.

16 Disclaimer of liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. (See rule 4, Decision to Race.) The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

17 Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.

18 Further information

All participants must be registered in the Bureau before the first warning signal.

Upon registration the following must be presented:

- Valid Class certificate (Only Optimist A, Zoom8 and Europe)
- Deceleration of boat borrowed from 3 party (not necessary for boat own by a club)
- Certificate of insurance (see paragraph 17)
- List of equipment for each participant must be placed and kept at the Bureau while racing (only Optimist A) – can be downloaded from www.ocd.dk/con30.php4
- Optimist A shall only use the equipment listed on the list of equipment, unless written approval has been given by the Race Committee.
